

Subject: Merit Based Scholarships for Graduate Students

Incoming graduate students are not offered merit-based scholarships for their performance prior to being enrolled in ADA University.

However, returning graduate students are eligible for scholarships.

• List of High Performance

Students scoring in the top 10% of each program cohort are granted 20% waiver off their tuition and receive the honor.

Students have to maintain a full course load by earned hours in order to be eligible for Merit Based Scholarships. Students found in violation of the ADA University Honor Code and Student Code of Conduct once will not be eligible for scholarship for the remainder of their tenure at the University. If a student has one failing grade (F, NP) in the given semester, he/she is not eligible for merit-based scholarship.

Cumulative GPA may be referred to when two or more students have the same GPA. Scholarship is awarded by GPA in effect as of the day of award.

Grades of graduate students studying in an exchange program at another institution are not calculated in GPA. Therefore, they cannot be considered for a merit-based scholarship.
