## 4261. Heroes Tribute Scholarship

- 1.1. Incoming and returning students can apply to Heroes Tribute Scholarship during their tenure at ADA University.
- 1.2. Incoming and returning student must meet one of the below requirements in order to be eligible for the Heroes Tribute Scholarship:
  - 1.2.1. Prospective student and/or enrolled student must be a current member of the Armed Services of the Republic of Azerbaijan
  - 1.2.2. Prospective student and/or enrolled student must be a "National Hero" or a child of a person with "National Hero" status
  - 1.2.3. Prospective student and/or enrolled student must be a child of a person who has been disabled or fallen as a result of 20 January events
  - 1.2.4. Prospective student and/or enrolled student must be a child or spouse of a military serviceman wounded in war
  - 1.2.5. Prospective student and/or enrolled student must be a spouse of a military serviceman fallen in war
  - 1.2.6. Prospective student and/or enrolled student must be a child of a current military serviceman and/or Armed Forces pensioner with military disability.
- 1.3. Eligible students receive a 100 percent tuition waiver for the first semester of study.
- 1.4. As of the second semester, returning students who accumulate a Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.00 or higher or successfully pass EAPP level in undergraduate and 2.75 or higher in graduate programs receive a 100 percent tuition waiver. These standards are for the semester.
- 1.5. Eligible students must maintain a full load coursework by earned hours.
- 1.6. Undergraduate students can study maximum 4 years/8 terms in a degree program (Fall and Spring terms only) plus maximum 1 year/2 terms in an EAPP program starting from the admission term by using Heroes Tribute Scholarship, whereas graduate students can study maximum 2 years/4 terms (Fall and Spring terms only) starting from the admission term by using Heroes Tribute Scholarship.
- 1.7. In case of prolongation of the study for documented medical emergencies and/or other personal issues out of students' control, Heroes Tribute Scholarship may be awarded for one additional term only.
