4251. Students with A Status of Internally Displaced Person, Children of Disabled War

## 4251. Students with A Status of Internally Displaced Person, Children of Disabled War Veterans, Children Deprived of Parental Care, Limited Health ability, and Children from Family of Martyrs

- 1.1. Incoming students with a status of internally displaced person (IDP), children of disabled war veterans (CDWV), war veterans (WVT), children deprived of parental care (CDPC), limited health ability (DLH), and children from family of martyrs (CFM) receive a 100 percent tuition waiver for the first year of study upon providing required documentation.
- 1.2. IDP students must meet below requirements to continue to receive a 100 percent tuition waiver:
  - 1.2.1. As of the second year, returning students who accumulate a term Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.00 or higher in undergraduate and a term Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.00 or higher in graduate programs receive a 100 percent tuition waiver.
  - 1.2.2. Students must maintain a full load coursework.
  - 1.2.3. Students with IDP status are required to submit stamped confirmation of their status on a yearly basis to maintain their waivers.
  - 1.2.4. ADA University will share the list of those undergraduate and graduate students scoring below 3.00 and 3.00 semester GPA, respectively, with the Government of Azerbaijan for further decision and funding.
- 1.3. Students found in violation of the ADA University Honor Code once will not be eligible for Special Status scholarships for the remainder of their tenure at the University.
- 1.4. Special Status scholarship does not apply to dual degree programs.
- 1.5. Undergraduate students can study maximum 5 years (10 semesters) if they are enrolled to EAPP program or 4 years (8 semesters) if they are directly enrolled to a degree program by using Special Status Scholarship, whereas graduate students can study maximum 2 years (4 semesters) by using Special Status Scholarship.
- 1.6. Special Status scholarship covers one education degree only one time for one level.
- 1.7. The students lose their Special Status waive if they reapply to degree through the State Examination Center of the Republic of Azerbaijan and ADA Admission office.
