State Program Scholarship

Fully funded by the State Program for Azerbaijani nationals, the program covers tuition, travel, and living expenses in Washington, D.C. Students only pay an annual non-refundable fee of 1,500 AZN. There is no post-graduation work requirement in Azerbaijan.
